



NEEDS FOR UGANDA

It is school time again. There are at least 40 children who have been going to school in Jinja, Uganda because of your generosity. Robert was also able to find a better house to live in recently that has 3 bedrooms (each holding 4, three-tier bunk-beds and 2 to a bunk), a bathroom, and a very little kitchen to put their 2-burner propane stove with a sink that is probably 10"x10". To them, this is an amazing thing and they must feel they are living in a mansion!

Many people in their community seek Robert Dasan out for help. Robert is 22 now and was only 19 when I first began corresponding with him. With the money that is sent each month, he buys enough food for him and the children he is responsible for and has some to share. On top of that, he helps villagers buy medicine, pay for hospital visits, and has even bought beds and mattresses for those who have no place to sleep except on dirt floors. These are mostly widows with small children or grandchildren. Many are sick with terminal disease and have no hope for life.
